

Heaps of holiday fun at new boardwalk

THERE will be plenty to celebrate at Dolphin Quay at the Mandurah Ocean Marina these school holidays, with clowns, face-painting and free ice-cream.

Guaranteed to beat holiday boredom, the free fun also marks the opening of a new 170m stretch of boardwalk at Dolphin Quay, that can be reached from Ormsby Terrace or via the pedestrian footbridge into the marina.

Jetties to build the new timber structure.

Lower than the existing boardwalk, the new section is good news for boaties who will be able to pull up alongside Dolphin Quay and enjoy access to the cafes, restaurants, markets and speciality shops.

A variety of free school holiday entertainment will be available between 11am and 3pm every day, including clowns and face painting.

Free ice-cream will be on offer from 1pm to 3pm on Saturday, July 14, for children under-14, and there will be musical entertainment from noon to 4pm on Sunday, July 8, 15 and 22.
