

Free children's entertainment at **Dolphin Quay**

HHEAD to Dolphin Quay at the Mandurah Ocean Marina these school holidays for free children's entertainment including clowns, face-painting and free ice-cream.

There's something organised between 11am and 3pm every day to help keep holiday boredom at bay. As well as clowning around and funny faces during the week, there will be free ice-cream on offer from 1pm until 3pm on Saturday, July 14 for children under the age of 14 years, plus the chance to

meet Dolphin Quay's loveable mascot, Dippy Dolphin.

There will be musical entertainment from mid-day until 4pm on Sunday, July 15 and again on Sunday, July 22.

The school holiday fun also marks the opening of a new 170m stretch of boardwalk at Dolphin Quay, which can be reached off Ormsby Terrace or via the pedestrian footbridge into the marina.

Marina consultant and former marina manager Jim Scott has been in

charge of the \$1million boardwalk improvements on behalf of the owners of Dolphin Quay, working with Mandurah business Southern Cross Jetties to build the new timber structure.

Lower than the existing boardwalk, the new section is especially good news for boaties who will be able to pull up alongside Dolphin Quay and enjoy user-friendly access to the cafés, restaurants, markets and speciality shops.

With a ramp at each end for wheelchair

access and with five sets of steps along its length, the new boardwalk is an important addition to Dolphin Quay which is set to welcome a range of new business ventures over the coming months.

A 1.5m high glass balustrade along the boardwalk will enhance enjoyment of Dolphin Quay's fabulous water-side location.
