

# Sisters use glass to bare souls

*WINDOWS of the Soul* is a unique exhibition opening at the weekend at Fusion Fine Arts by local artists Jean and June Pastore.

The exhibition created entirely in glass has also captured the interest of Foxtel's Gallery Watch program which will film the opening night celebrations.
