A hive of activity: The Mandurah Ocean Marina is always a hive of activity, being home to a mix of residential, commercial and tourism elements. It is also home to the Mandurah Emergency Water Rescue Group and the Mandurah Offshore Fishing and Sailing Club but this weekend it is also home to the Club Marine Mandurah Boat Show.

THE Mandurah Ocean Marina is fast becoming one of the major icons of Mandurah.

Developed by State Government property developer LandCorp and managed by the City of Mandurah, the marina is an aquatic playground and a hive of activity.

Professional fishing boats and a boating and fishing support industry, along with the Mandurah Emergency Water Rescue Group and the Mandurah Offshore Fishing and Sailing Club are located in one precinct.

Further around there are residential and short-term accommodation areas and great beaches.

Great walkways, public open space and a playground are all great areas to take it easy.

Undercover markets, shops, cafes and restaurants are all part of the Dolphin Quay area which has indoor and outdoor areas to have a drink or a meal.

There is plenty of parking at the marina or people can walk across a spectacular footbridge from the city centre.
